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Reminder: In-Home Assessment (IHA)

Effective August 3, 2020, Mi Via Pa rticipants will be contacted by phone to schedule their In-Hom e Assessment. The person calling will be the person doing the assessment. They will be calling from Goodwill Incorporated New Mexico (GINM). Please remember that the assessor will not be going into the Participant's home. Instead the Assessor will be doing the assessment using a computer or a mobile device. This is also called a "virtual visit". If the Participant is not able to take part in the virt ual visit because of poor internet connection or other computer a nd mobile device iss ues, the assessment will be re-sc heduled when the Public Health Order is over. Please respond to these GINM calls. Completing the assessment is needed for the Mi Via program.

Mi Via Waiver Renewal Update

Every five (5) years New Mexico needs to apply to Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for federal approval to keep the Mi Via Waiver program going. The State applied to CMS, asking that the Mi Via waiver be extended for another five (5) years starting October 1, 2020. The State will be providing you with updates.

Electronic Visit Verification (EVV)

EVV is a system that confirms when an employee has worked on the date and time they have been scheduled to work. EVV is a federal requirement of the 21st Century Cures Act, a United States law enacted by Congress in Decemb er of 2016. The EVV system will allow Employees to "clock in" and "clock out" by using a landline phone or a software applic ation also known and an "app" that has been downloaded on their mobile phone. EVV will help confirm that participants are getting the services they have asked for. EVV also helps the participant or Employer of Record (EOR) track employees and the time they work.

The State will start EVV for the Mi Via program by January 1, 2021. EVV will be used for the Homemaker, Respite, and In-home Living Supports services. The State, Conduent and your Consultant will assist you in learning how to use the EVV system. More information will be provided as it becomes available.
